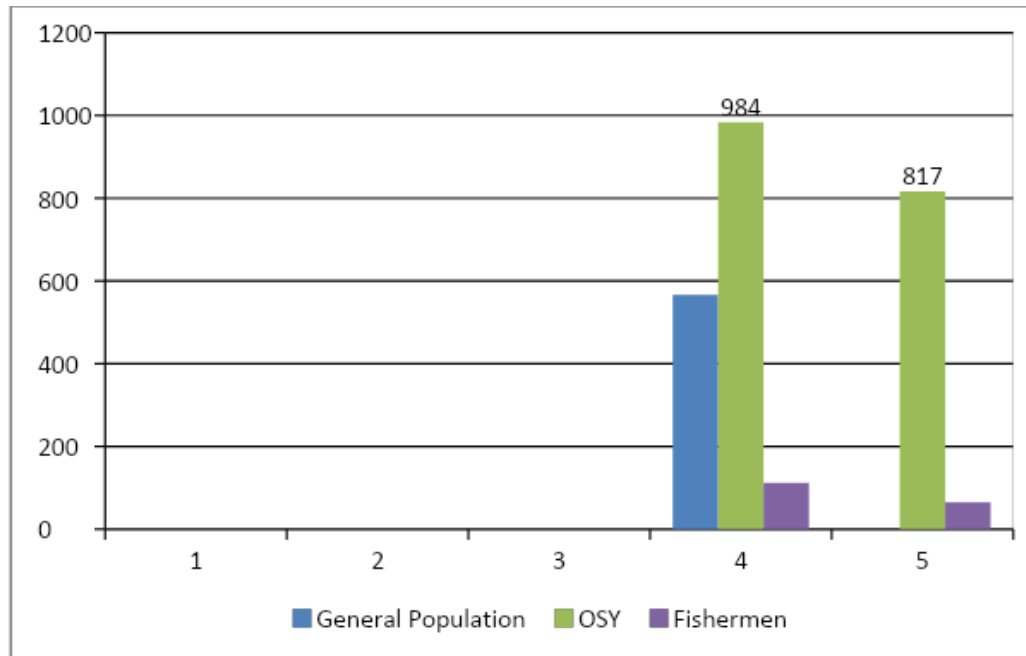
## 2. Activities Description

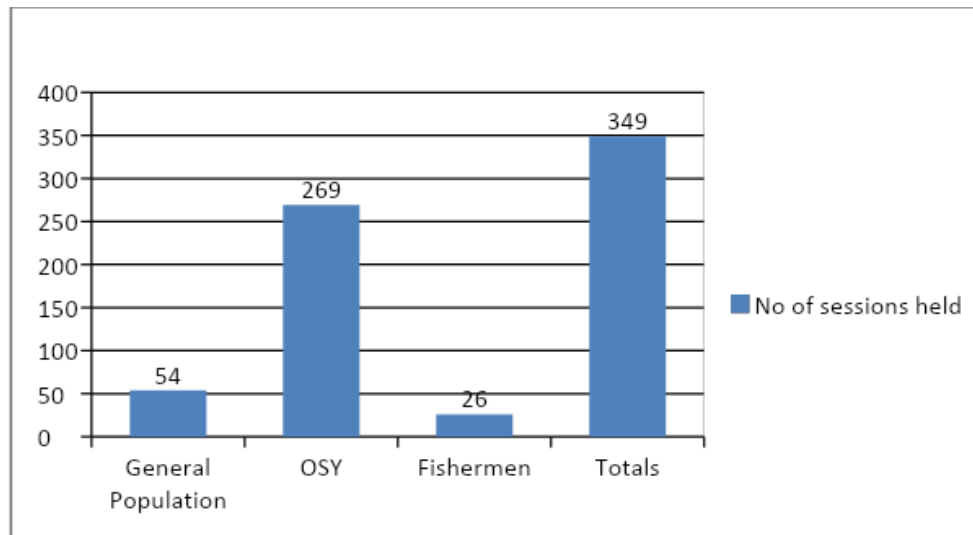
### I. Peer Sessions

To promote reduction of individual HIV/AIDS risk, peer sessions were conducted by 117 trained Peer Educators (PEs) among all the target populations comprised of Out-of-School Youth (OSY), Fishermen and Men and Women of Reproductive Age (General Population) in the target Local Government Areas namely: Oron, Okobo, Mbo, Ibeno, Nsit Atai and Udung Uko. The 117 PEs were made up of 9 Fishermen PEs, 90 Out-of-School Youth (OSY) PEs and 18 General Population PEs. The 117 PEs conducted a total of 346 peer sessions and reached a total of 3052 peers disaggregated into 1663 males and 1390 females through these sessions. There were 3053 new peers reached during the sessions. 1 out-of-school female was referred for HCT services during the peer sessions. The peer sessions were conducted between September 1st and September 31st, 2015.
