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#### PROJECT BACKGROUND

ealthy Mother Healthy Child Project is a TY Danjuma Foundation Funded Project being implemented by Antof Rural Resource Development Centre (ARRDEC) in three LGAs namely: Oti-Oro and Ekeya communities of Okobo LGA; Eyoabasi, Idua Assang and Esin Ufot Communities of Oron LGA; and Eyokponung, Eyibia and Ekim Communities of Udung Uko LGA of Akwa Ibom State. The project is being implemented under the sub-title, "Promoting uptake of ANC and PMTCT services at 2 PHCs each in Oron, Udung Uko and Okobo LGAs for improved IMNCH in 11 months", and the primary target populations are pregnant women and HIV exposed infants.

The objective of the Project is to contribute to reducing the prevalence of under-five and maternal mortality in Akwa Ibom State, therefore to achieve this, the project worked with the beneficiaries, host communities, engaged the various community structures that impact women's care-seeking behaviour to promote uptake of ANC and PMTCT services at the selected Primary healthcare Centres in the project locations. Results-focused activities carried out included: Community-based Outreaches to create demand for uptake of ANC and PMTCT, HIV Counseling Services, referrals and follow-up for adherence to treatment for HIV-positive women.

#### PROJECT CLOSE-OUT AND AWARD CEREMONY, on 17th Dec., 2019


- Held at Antofitel Hotel & Suites, 13 EbongStreet, Oron, Akwa Ibom State,

- 12 persons; 5 TBAs, 1 PPMV, 1 Community Chief, 1 Mentor Mother, 1 Case Manager and 3 Community Volunteers, (CVs), were awarded as Healthy Mother, Healthy Child Champions for their commitment to promoting Antenatal Care (ANC) attendance and Child Immunization.


### Number of pregnant women enrolled for ANC

By end of Project March 2019 - Dec., 2019 Pregnant women enrolled for Ante Natal Care 225.2% Increase


## Number of pregnant women enrolled for ANC who made at least 4 visits at the facilities




**Before Project** April2018 - Feb. 2019 Pregnant women made at least 4 ANC visits


